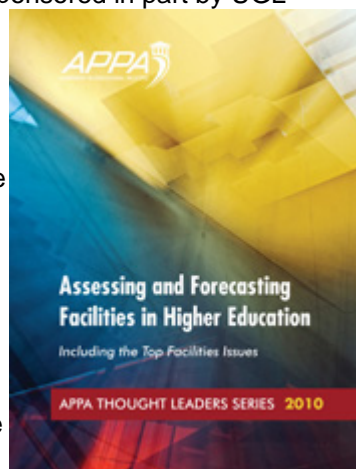

Strategic Capital Development: The New Model for Campus Investment, by Harvey H. Kaiser and Eva Klein, presents a bold approach for planning capital investments from a strategic and long-range perspective. - **Part 3** provides the proposed model. It offers practical, hands-on, how-to details of methodologies and data requirements, along with illustrations of many of these elements.

EPA Issues Guidance to Address Proper Maintenance, Removal, and Disposal of PCB-Containing Fluorescent Lights

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) released guidance recommending that schools take steps to reduce potential exposures to PCBs from older fluorescent lighting fixtures. The guidance, part of EPA's ongoing efforts to address potential PCB exposures in schools, is based on evidence that the older ballasts contain PCBs that can leak when the ballasts fail, leading to elevated levels of PCBs in the air of schools that should not represent an immediate threat but could pose health concerns if they persist over time.
