IFMA's "Facilities Snapshot" Poll Shows Slight Uptick in Facilities Management Hiring

Education sector promises to do the most hiring

The results of the "Facilities Snapshot" poll have recently been released, and they have news for educational facilities managers. The "Snapshot" is a quarterly survey of International Facility Management Association members that highlights the latest developments affecting the profession and serves as a barometer of facility management activity worldwide. Among the findings, results for the third quarter 2010 show a slight increase in facility management hiring, with 20% of respondents reporting that they will hire facility staff within the next six months, up from 16% for the previous quarter. Healthcare and education are the industry sectors showing the greatest potential for growth. While most survey respondents report only modest — if any — plans to expand the space they manage over the next six months, 47% of healthcare facility professionals say their organizations plan to expand. Education, on the other hand, is the industry sector that promises to do the most hiring, as 32% of respondents say their organizations plan to hire additional facilities staff over the next six months. AIA Selects Six Communities for Community Assistance Program to Promote Long-term Sustainability

The American Institute of Architects (AIA) has selected six communities to receive technical assistance under the Sustainable Design Assessment Team (SDAT) program in 2011: Shelburne, Vermont; Apple Valley, Minnesota; Pikes Peak Region, Colorado; Southwest DeKalb County, Georgia; Bastrop, Texas; and Santa Rosa, California. Also, the City of New Orleans has been selected to receive technical assistance under the Design Assistance Team program, a project that will occur in conjunction with the commencement of the AIA's annual convention in New Orleans in May. SDAT program represents a



significant institutional investment by the AIA in public service work to assist communities in developing policy frameworks and long-term sustainability plans. It brings together architects and other professionals to provide a roadmap for communities seeking to improve their sustainability – as defined by a community’s ability to meet the environmental, economic, and social equity needs of today without reducing the ability of future generations to meet their needs.
