Financial

The MAPPA Board has worked to reduce reserve balances the past 3 years by awarding scholarships to members to attend the annual conference or APPA University. This has been very successful as an additional 7 scholarships to attend the APPA Institute or Leadership Academy were again presented to MAPPA members during the year. As the reserves have decreased, the Board has limited the number of scholarships offered. At the same time, members are urged to continue to apply for support. The MAPPA Board continues to look at opportunities that will enhance the number of scholarships awarded on an annual basis. Annual membership renewals along with positive budget numbers from the annual conference will determine the threshold for the Board to offer future support.

Additional Updates

MAPPA President, Steve Gilsdorf, continued regular calls with chapter presidents to exchange information from APPA, MAPPA and the state chapters. These chapter presidents then had the opportunity to participate (in a non-voting capacity) with the MAPPA Board conference calls, enhancing engagement and knowledge on a variety of topics for the organization.

Indiana, Iowa and Illinois have recently hosted their own state chapter conferences. Minnesota is beginning the process to be a state chapter and using the upcoming MAPPA conference to build momentum.

Two vacancies occurred on the MAPPA Board during the course of the year. Past members, Art Chonko and Becky Barnes stepped back into prior roles, again offering their expertise and knowledge.

The MAPPA Board continued to review the new APPA strategic plan, incorporating new ways to support the enhanced direction for the organization.
