Key Concepts to Building Effective Teams

People Matter

- Encourage the Positive
- Recognize Strong Performance
- Confront the Ugly (OTFD)
- Communication/Respect/Honesty

Key Concepts to Building Effective Teams

Communication and Consistency

- Say what you are going to do and do it
- Over communication is not possible
- Listen as much as (more than) you talk

Key Concepts to Building Effective Teams

Effective Leadership

- Tell the story - Why are we here?
- Clarify/set roles
- Effective Change Management
- Solve Problems – Remove obstacles and provide tools for success
- Challenge/correct poor performance
- It's not easy – And will likely get ugly

Key Concepts to Building Effective Teams

Make it Practical

- Clear mission statement
- Team Build-In – Solicit input
- Clarify (and document) values if necessary
- Set clear expectations – Supervisor and PPM
Rules and Regulations
- Describe what success looks like
