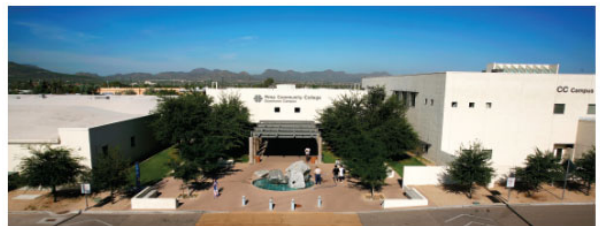
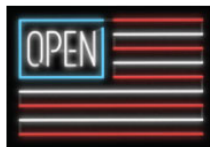
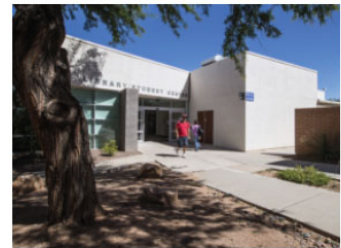




Guidelines for Social Distancing Instructional Space Protocols



Summer 2020

Introduction

This document illustrates recommended layouts for instructional learning spaces throughout the College utilizing the latest [Center for Disease Control and Prevention](#), the [Arizona Department of Health Services](#), and the Pima County Health Department [Guidelines](#) for Social Distancing. All of the layouts depicted in this document are using the existing classroom furniture and a staggered desk assignment for students.

Facilities Reentry Protocol

COVID-19 Restrictions

Individuals that meet any of the following criteria must not enter College facilities:

- Have been diagnosed with positive COVID-19 by a medical provider.
- Have been in close contact with a person known to have COVID-19 within the last fourteen (14) days.
- Displays known COVID19 symptoms, including but not limited to:
 - Fever – The CDC considers a person to have a fever when he or she has a measured temperature of at least 100.4°F {38°C}
 - Cough
 - Shortness of breath
- Individuals who are sick must stay home and contact their health care provider for further directions.

Access Protocol

Access requests must be received at least 72 hours prior to arrival time.

- 1) **Employees** must email their supervisor and be clear on the details and purpose. Requests should be routed to the Executive Administrator for approval and strictly scrutinized prior to authorizing. The Executive Administrator will send an email to Acting Chief of Police requesting approval for entry.

Contractors/Tenants request access authorization through the sponsoring unit/department representative. Sponsoring unit/department will send an email to Acting Chief of Police requesting approval for entry.

- 2) Notify College Police dispatch when arriving/leaving the facility on a daily basis at 520-206-2700.
- 3) Access to any of our facilities will be approved or denied by the Chief of Police.
 - a) Approval will be sent to EH&S to provide Personal Protective Equipment (PPE).
 - b) Contractors are responsible for their own personal protective equipment, unless other arrangements have been made in advance.
- 4) Access is granted for the day/time approved only.
- 5) Go directly to the designated checkpoint at each location (see attached maps) to sign-in.

- a) PPE will be available at the check-in point.
- b) Temperature screening will be conducted at the check-in point.
- 6) Go directly to ONLY the area for which access was approved.
- 7) Time limit - 30 minute MAX. or as approved to cover instructional session duration.
- 8) Return to the designated checkpoint to sign-out.

Personal Protective Equipment

Gaining access requires individuals to wear the following PPE:

- Gloves
- Mask

What is social distancing?

Social distancing, referred to as “physical distancing,” means maintaining space between yourself and other people outside of your home. To practice social or physical distancing:

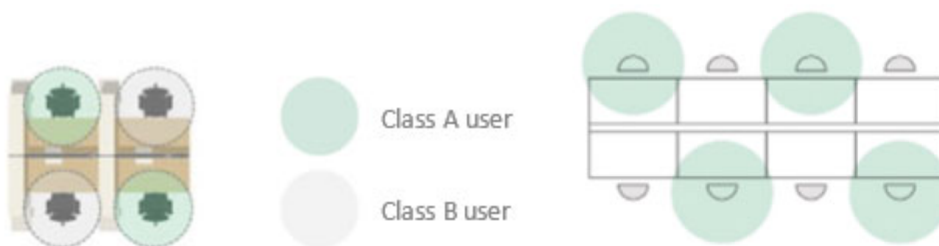
- Stay at least 6 feet (about 2 arms’ length) from other people
- Do not gather in groups
- Avoid crowded places and mass gatherings

Instructional Layout and Programming:

- Coordinate temperature check station locations with campus leadership
- Plan temporary check-in locations for faculty and students
- Install directional and instructional signage throughout
- Seating tagged with color-coding
- Sanitization services provided by custodians in between layout options rotations

Staggered Desk Assignment

- Alternating Classes
- No Desk Sharing
- Reduce sanitization required between each class

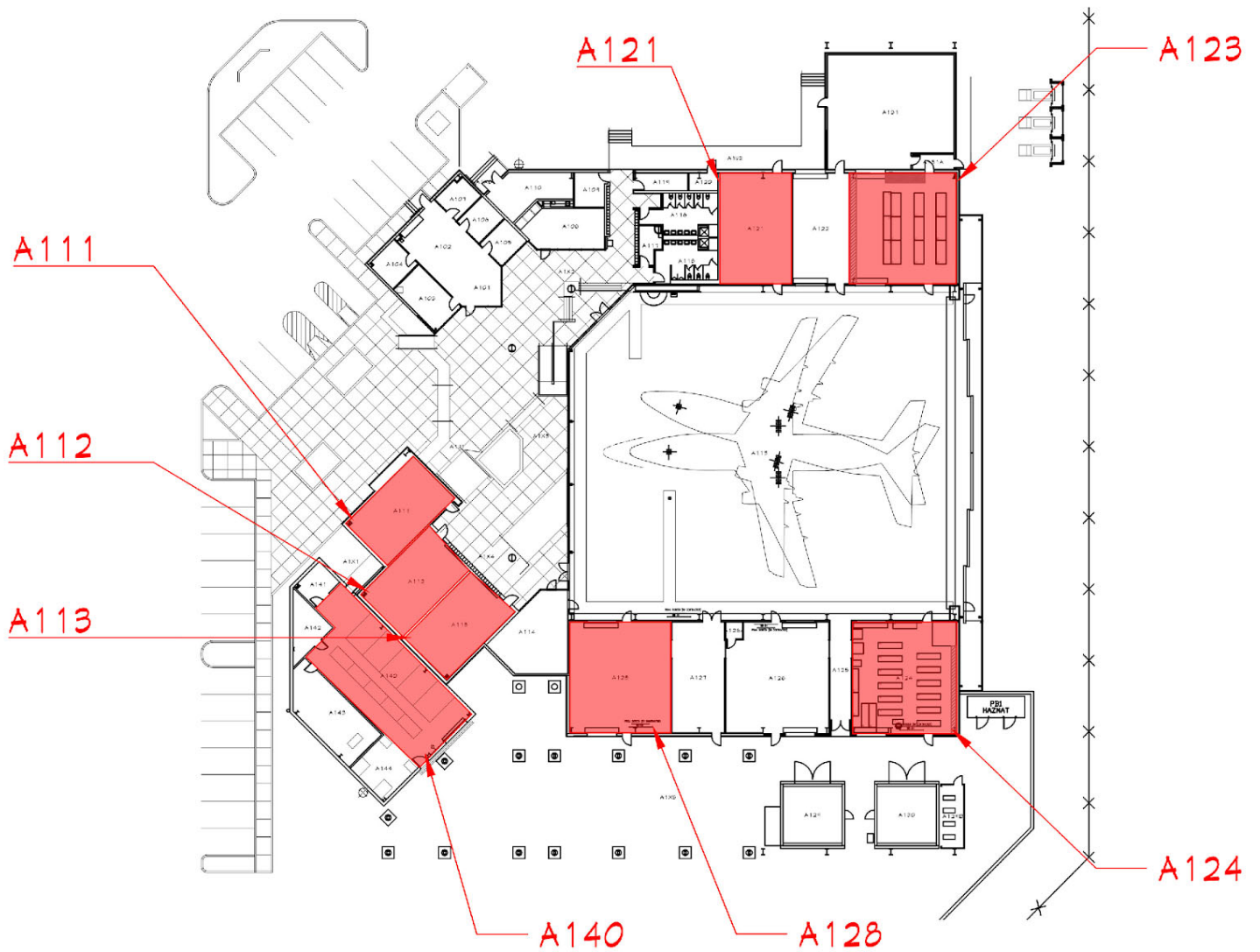

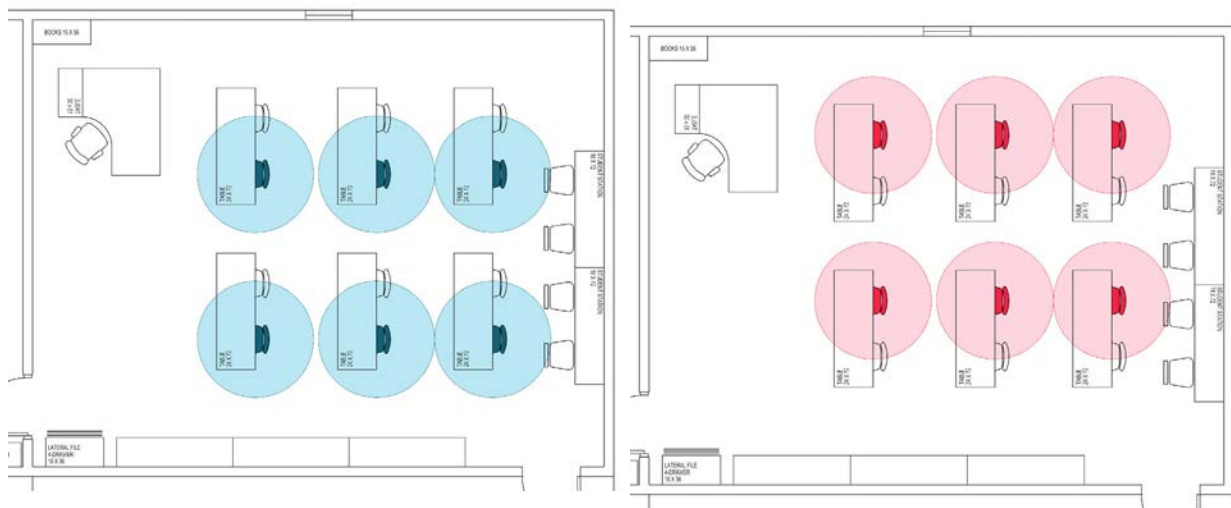
Truck Driving Range A100

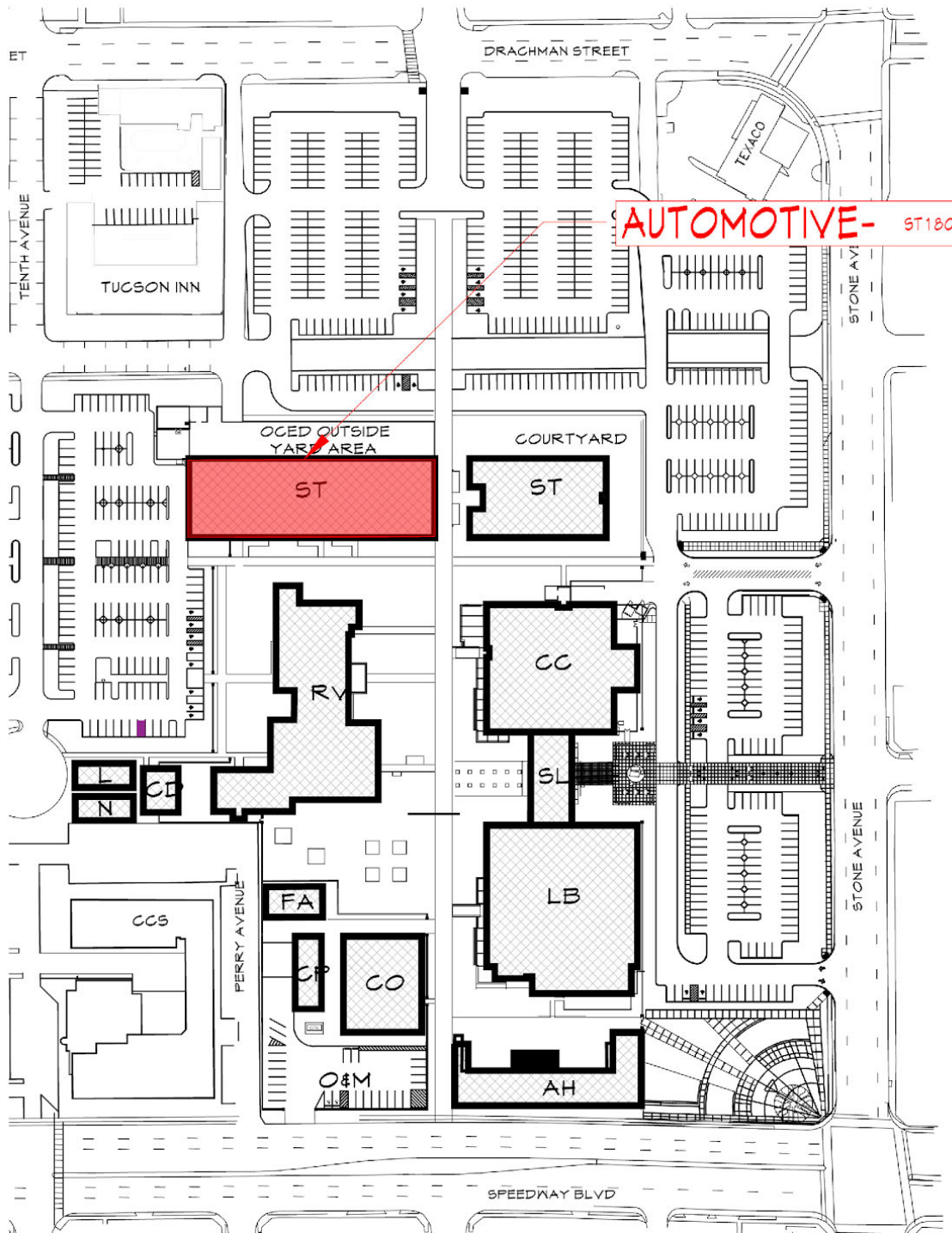
